Moods and Modes is thrilled to announce the release of the latest album by Aneta George and Martin Milcent Trio entitled *Playground* available on all platforms.

'When you listen with your heart, the whole world is your playground.'- this is the main message of the new studio album of Aneta George, a jazz/world music singer and composer. This project is a joint composing effort with the french pianist Martin Milcent, who brought the grooves and the harmonies to the project, matching perfectly with Aneta's melodies and lyrics, like a beautiful mosaic.



It's a jazz quartet structure; the specific illumination that the bassist Marius Gerin and drummer Elie Akkouche bring, adds warmth and playfulness to the overall sound of the album. 'We wanted to create jazz music, with pop approach, says Martin, the vertical structure and groove is jazz, but the form of the songs is pop, short, precise and with very little soloing'.

The other side of the album is odd rhythms and the Macedonian etno heritage that Aneta brings, which becomes something exotic and exciting to play for French musicians. 'In this album I wanted to sing about ordinary topics', says Aneta, 'like how's my day, my introvert side, something that fascinates me with other people, some patterns and behaviors. But through all that, my underlying message is that we need to listen with our hearts: to each other, to our selves, to the Universe.'



Vocalists who are relatively new to jazz tend to play it safe and often stick to a tried-and-true set of standards, as close as possible to the interpretations of those standards they are familiar with. You really have to be brave and sure of your compositional and vocal capabilities to come up with a full set of originals which discerning listeners would be satisfied with.





in the recently re-named country of North Macedonia, and now working and living in France, she originally started out as a soul/pop singer, favoring pop stars like Stevie Wonder and Boys II Men. She started piano studies late, with no proper piano training to start with, and only took vocal training a few years back when she moved to Paris.

But, if you've got talent, it is never too late, and on *Playground* Aneta shows plenty of it, as a composer and a vocalist. With excellent support from the Martin Milicent Trio, she is able to come up with some excellent compositions, such as "Give it time," the title track and "Stronger." George seems confident in the jazz territory, with some great vocal skills, without completely abandoning her soul/pop roots. Even when her songs show room for further development, like "Wounded Animal," her vocal skills and the trio pull her through, without too many problems, following it up with vocal capabilities full of promise on "Radishani-Chatenoy." *Playground* certainly leaves room for improvement but, at the same time, is assured and accomplished, pointing in the right direction for a very promising vocalist and composer.
